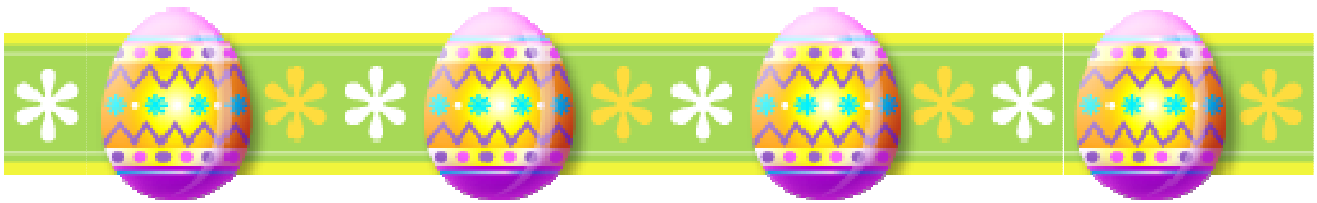


# Easter Weekend at HYC

*please join us for an Easter weekend filled with Family Fun!*



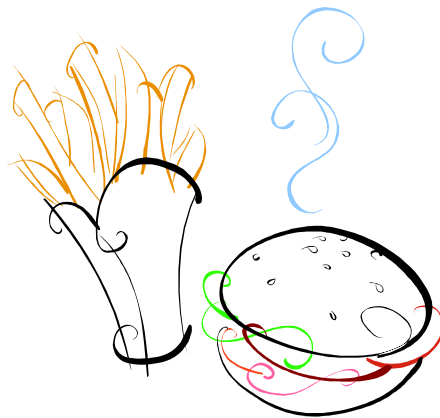
The Galley is preparing some special goodies and treats for the weekend, and if you are a chocolate and especially an Easter egg lover, you should not miss out!!
